Mission:

The Education Committee is responsible for providing coordination and oversight of the development, implementation and evaluation of the high quality and impactful continuing medical education (CME) activities. Additionally, the Committee will support AANA in insuring the policies, standards, and guidelines of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgeons (ABOS), the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), and the Council of Medical Specialty Societies (CMSS) are followed to include oversight of compliance, needs assessment and evaluation and COI for all activities.

Primary Responsibilities:

- 1) Evaluate the Annual Meeting abstracts.
- 2) Plan, implement and evaluate Co-Provided and Joint-Provided programs.
- 3) Review needs assessment data, identify practice gaps and measure outcomes data from all AANA's educational programs and provide to planning committees.
