2019 Fellows Scholarship Guidelines

- Applicant must have completed a residency and currently be in an Orthopaedic fellowship program, demonstrate enthusiasm for and have a sincere interest in arthroscopic surgery, be in good academic standing and obtain recommendation from his/her fellowship training program director.
- The scholarship is awarded for one course and acceptance of it requires commitment to attend the AANA Second Annual Fellows Course, June 7-9, 2019 only. The scholarship provides \$500 per recipient and up to four recipients will be chosen.
- It is the responsibility of the recipient to contact the AANA office to confirm their status for the course. The Learning Center Committee reserves the right to review all incoming applications and has the right to adjust accordingly.
- The AANA Education Foundation process requires that you write a one page essay of 500 words or less and a letter of recommendation to be considered for an award. The Arthroscopy Association of North America encourages diversity of applicants and institutions.
- The closing date for receipt of completed applications and all supporting documents for is April 30, 2019.
- If sent after the closing date, your application will not be accepted.
