Mission:

The Research Committee is responsible for oversight and management of the AANA research program.

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Oversee the research grant submission, evaluation, rate and selection process.
2. Promote both basic science and clinical research outcomes of AANA research.
3. Select the four named Research Awards from Annual Meeting Abstracts.
4. Pursue partnerships with outside entities to conduct research that supports Arthroscopy and minimally invasive surgery as well as CPT related studies.
5. Provide assessment reports as necessary for AANA facilitated surveys.
6. Assess internal data and work collaboratively to ensure the gathering and recording of necessary demographic and other member data.
7. Provide committee member names for review of applications or information when appropriate e.g., ORS).
8. Oversee the submission, evaluation, rate and selection process for special grant initiatives e.g., MAST Summit.
9. Review survey requests for the AANA Survey Portal.

Time Commitment:

Includes one in-person meeting at Annual Meeting, conference calls as needed and independent work.

Committee Size:

A total of 15-20 members are needed to successfully complete the committee's work.

Qualifications:

Any AANA physician member interested in basic science and clinical research.
