



EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Mission:

The Education Committee is responsible for providing coordination and oversight of the development, implementation and evaluation of the continuing medical education (CME) activities. Additionally, the Committee will support AANA in ensuring the policies, standards, and guidelines of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgeons (ABOS), the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), and the Council of Medical Specialty Societies (CMSS) are followed.

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Through the Annual Meeting Work Group, consisting of the immediate past, current, and next annual meeting chair and the ICL lead, develop all educational aspects of the Annual Meeting program including but not limited to Instructional Course Lectures, Scientific Sessions, Podium and ePosters, and other sessions as necessary/appropriate.
2. Partner with other societies based on MOUs for joint sessions (e.g., ISAKOS, SLARD, ASES).
3. Plan, implement and evaluate Co-Provided and Joint-Provided programs e.g., Specialty Day.
4. Review needs assessment data, identify practice gaps and measure outcomes data from all AANA's educational programs and provide to planning groups (e.g., Surgical Skills, Annual Meeting, Specialty Day).
5. Determine content for webinars and other online programming.
6. Assess new learning formats/technologies and incorporate into educational activities.
7. Determine focused initiatives and direct work-groups with the overall committee to facilitate (e.g., Faculty Resources, Practice Management offerings)
8. Oversee the CORE Work Group for development of the ACGME-based selection of recorded webinars.
9. Oversee the CASE Work Group for development of the annual Self-Assessment offering.

Time Commitment:

Includes one in-person meeting at Annual Meeting, conference calls as needed and independent work.

Committee Size:

A total of 40 members are needed to successfully complete the committee's work.

Qualifications:

Any AANA physician member interested in the development and delivery of educational content in a variety of modalities to improve patient care.
