



MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Evaluate FAANA applications and recommend acceptance or denial for the designation program.
2. Serve as an advocate for AANA. Communicate the benefits of membership to non-members, encourage them to join, and when necessary, serve as their sponsor or facilitate an introduction to a sponsor.
3. Provide support of member recruitment and retention initiatives.
4. Provide input and guidance to staff on member benefits and enhancements.
5. Upon the request of the President, make appropriate inquiry into any complaints or changes concerning members and make recommendations consistent with the AANA Bylaws.

Time Commitment:

Conference calls as needed.

Independent work to evaluate FAANA applications, work on member benefit projects and promote membership.

Committee Size:

A total of 16-18 members are needed to successfully accomplish the committee's work.
